“ I am so sad to hear of Terrance's "Big O" passing. I am sorry for his Family and Friends' loss of this great person. I consider myself better for having known him. We served together in 2005-2007 based out of Ft. Carson, CO. The one thing that became extremely useful in our relationship was his calming patience. How I led for the rest of my career and life was molded during our time together. I only wish I had told him that in person. We shared our last Rocket attack (he beat me over the wall) at FOB Warhorse in NOV '06, and then our first PTSD experience together at Fort Carson, CO a week later during the Retreat Ceremony. When the cannon fired, we both flinched, and he looked at me and said "you too, huh?" He was an incredible Fire Support NCO who always took care of his Team and Leaders, as well as meticulously accomplishing the mission. No matter his emphatic persistence, I never did adopt and employ his Excel and Accent Programs with all his "dropdown" menus- although I acknowledge the job would have been much easier had I. I know it was through his leadership in the 3/4 FECC that we decisively beat the uprising in MAR-APR '08. I am glad I wasn't in his presence when his beloved Eagles beat my Patriots in '18, His quiet demeanor would've been no more, he wouldn't have shut his mouth over that- I would give anything to hear him now though... A flood of emotions and memories have consumed me the past couple of days, I only wish I was better at telling him how high in regard I held him. I will always remember that look out of the corner of his eye, with that slight grin to tell me - OK, you think so, when I would present some crazy idea.
